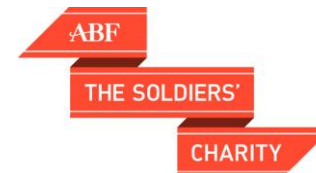

About Gift Aid

- By using Gift Aid, ABF The Soldiers' Charity will receive an extra 25 pence from HM Revenue & Customs for every pound you give, helping your donation go further at no extra cost to you.
- It does not matter at what rate you pay UK tax. This includes income tax, tax deducted from bank or building society interest, the tax credit on dividends from UK companies or other capital gains tax. If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
- A Gift Aid declaration can be given in writing, either by post or fax, on-line or by email. They may also be given orally, either by telephone or face to face. If given orally we will write to confirm that we have received a declaration from you.
- You can cancel your declaration at any time by notifying us, for example if your circumstances change and you no longer pay income tax.
